Gas Broiler Power Cord Replacement Kits:

Kit # 1403-70R - 120V with Terminal

Kit # 1415-10R - 220V

CAUTION: Read and understand this service bulletin thoroughly before starting. Only a trained, experienced service technician should attempt this service procedure.

The replacement cord kits come in two voltages - 120V or 220V. Be sure you have the correct replacement cord.




Figure 1 - Power Cord Replacement - 120V and 220V

Instructions With White Plastic Connectors

If current set up <u>includes</u> white plastic connectors, then remove old part and replace with new.

- 1. Unscrew acorn nut and cover to get to wires.
- 2. Remove blue wire nut and separate white wires.
- 3. Disconnect white connector from on-off switch and remove power cord wire.
- 4. Remove ground screw and remove power cord.
- 5. Slide new power cord wire with pin into the white connector and connect to on-off switch.
- 6. Reattach ground screw to ground power cord.
- 7. Connect white wires with blue wire nut.
- 8. Fit all wires back into box and tighten cover with acorn nut.

Instructions Without White Plastic Connectors

If current set up <u>does not include</u> white plastic connectors, follow steps to prepare for blue wire nuts.

- 1. Unscrew acorn nut and cover to get to wires.
- 2. Remove blue wire nut (2) connecting the power cord to the on-off switch and motor.
- 3. Remove ground screw and remove power cord.
- 4. Prep new power cord:
 - a. Cut pin off of black wire and strip 0.5" from black wire.
 - b. Do not touch other wires.
- 5. Reattach ground screw to ground power cord.
- 6. Connect wires using blue wire nuts per wire diagram.
- 7. Fit all wires back into box and tighten cover with acorn nut.

AVOID ERROR IN PARTS SELECTION. When ordering use complete EmberGlo Part Number and Description. Furnish the Product Model Number, Bill of Material Number and Serial Number (if available) from the specification plate found on the product.
